SET UP HOURS: Noon -7 P.M. on Thursday, June, 15th or 7-9 A.M. Friday, June 16th (Must be complete by 9 A.M.)

SHOW HOURS: 9 A.M. -5 P.M. on Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

TAKE DOWN: starts at 5 P.M. Sunday, June 17th. Display must be removed by 8 P.M. Sunday.

SECURITY: Security will be provided from 12 noon on Thursday, June 15th to 8:00 P.M. on Sunday, June 17th. All precautions will be taken to protect the property and person of each exhibitor. However, it is mutually agreed that the Show Chairperson 2007, the Palmdale Gem & Mineral Club, the California Federation of Mineralogical Societies, the Antelope Valley Fairgrounds, their members and employees assume no liability for damage to or loss or destruction of any exhibit, in whole or in part. This includes injury to a person from any cause. The exhibitor agrees to hold the above named entities and their members harmless from any and all claims, demands, suits, liability, damages, loss, cost, attorney fees, and expenses of any kind which might arise from attendance or participation in this show, or arising out of use of the fairgrounds premises. Submission of the signed application for exhibitor space constitutes acceptance of this clause.

LIGHTING – Exhibits are limited to 150 watts of power per 4 foot display.

APPLICATION: Please fill in the following information and return as soon as possible to the address below. **APPLICATION DEADLINE: MAY 15, 2007.** Applications will be accepted in the order received. We plan to display a total of 100 competition and non-competition cases. Please indicate if you require an end location for wheelchair access or other special needs.

There are only 50 cases available for Non-Competitive Exhibits; they are supplied by the Antelope Valley Fair. The measurements for the liners for these cases are 48-3/4” long x 21-1/2” deep x 20” high x 3/8” thick. The 3/8” applies mostly to the sidepieces, which will not clear the lights if it is thicker.

PASSES: Each exhibitor will receive one, 1 day pass. (Additional passes may be obtained at the show at the discretion of the show management)
